Light Control and Privacy

Sheer: Semi-transparent fabric that allows light to filter through. Images and shapes can be seen through these shades.

Light Filtering: Allows light to gently filter through and provides privacy. Images and shapes may be seen through these shades, but details are not visible. Deep fabric color provides moderate light control; light fabric color provides lower light control.

Room Darkening: Allows some light to filter into the room and provides privacy. Objects in a lit room seen through these shades appear as vague shapes. Deep fabric color darkens a room; light fabric color filters and diffuses bright sunlight.

Fabric Disclaimers

To ensure color consistency and avoid dye lot variation, please order all shades for the same room at the same time.

Fabrics cannot be seamed or overlapped.

Colors may appear to vary depending on the time of day and lighting type as well as when the shade is partially or fully lowered.

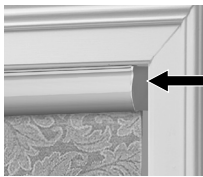

Continuous-Loop Lift

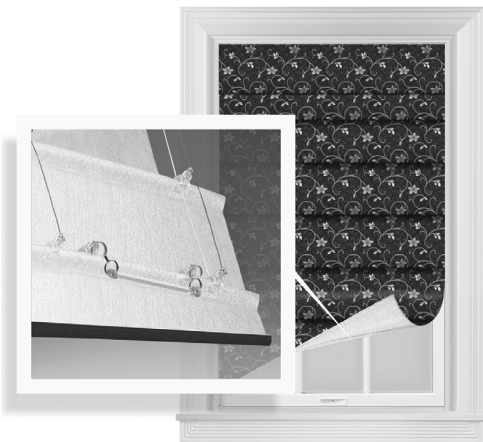


- **For surcharge, see price charts**
- A single, white continuous-loop lift cord raises and lowers the shade; the cord is always the same length
- The clutch mechanism in the color coordinated aluminum headrail assists in raising and lowering the shade; it stops the shade at any point and holds the bottomrail level
- Continuous-loop lift comes with a locking cord loop guide; for shade operation, this tensioner must be installed
- Available on both flat and looped styles
- Control length for continuous-loop lift shades varies based on the finished shade height (see below); optional cord loop length (sizes listed in chart) available upon request

Cordless Lift



Horizontal Wand

- Provides safety with no external cords on front of shade
- Ideal for homes with children or pets
- Provides clean aesthetics
- Available on both flat and looped styles
- Vertical wand is used with bottom panels greater than 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
- Horizontal wand is used with bottom panels less than 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ "
- Shades wider than 48" have two wands for shade operation

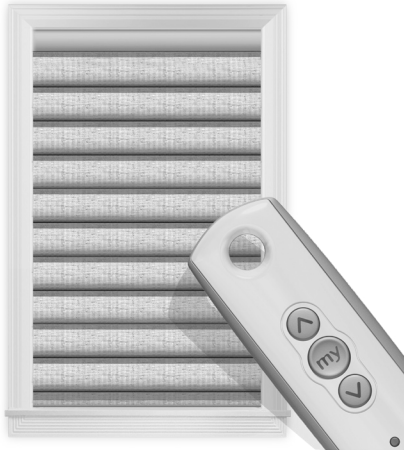
NOTE: All cordless lift shades need to be used on windows where consumers can comfortably raise and lower them.



Vertical Wand

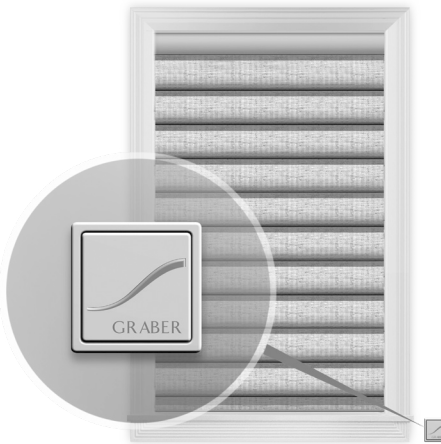

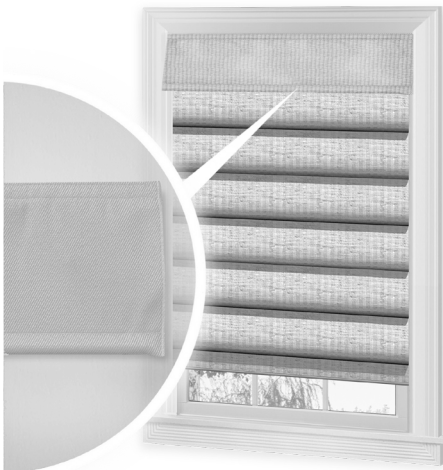

- Low voltage motorization requires no costly electrical hardwiring
- Multiple control and power options available

Fabric Valance Only



- Coordinating fabric valance creates an uninterrupted look and conceals the headrail
- Edges are finished and attached to the headrail with hook and loop tape
- Fabric valance returns are not available
- Continuous valance is only available up to fabric width
- Bead and gimp trims available; see trim page in shade options

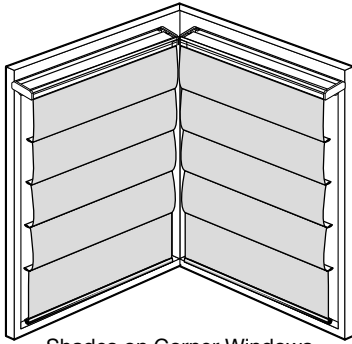

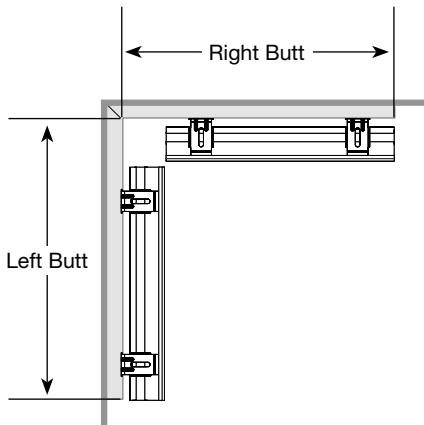
Options

Corner Windows



Shades on Corner Windows

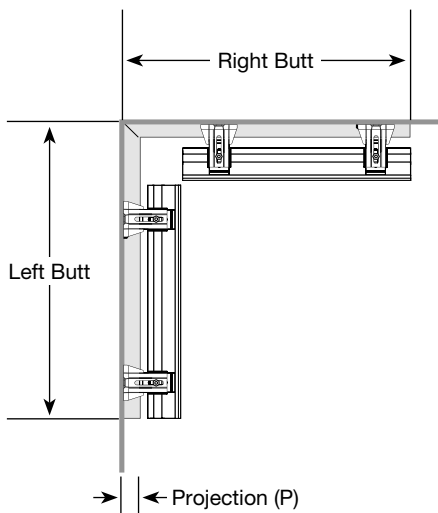
- **No charge**
- Made as individual shades
- Each shade will have its own control; we recommend opposite corners
- Indicate left or right for each shade
- Manufacturer will take appropriate deductions for proper fit; DO NOT order as a corner shade if you do not want manufacturer to take deductions
- **Cornices or decorative wood valances are not available on corner windows**
- Flat style is recommended for corner windows
- Looped style will have light gaps due to fabric loops



Measuring Information

Mounting on a Wall or Molding:

Measure the width of each window from the corner on the mounting surface (molding or wall) to the point you would like to cover.



Mounting Above the Molding:

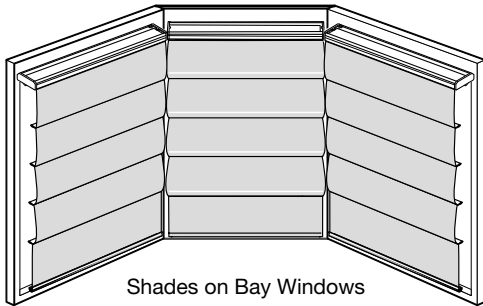
Measure the width of each window from the corner on the mounting surface to the point you would like to cover.

Projection measurement is the distance needed to clear any molding or obstructions that the shade will be mounted above.

NOTE: The projection (P) distance is needed to correctly calculate deductions for installations where the shades will use shims or projection brackets to clear molding. All projection distances must match for correct deductions to be calculated.

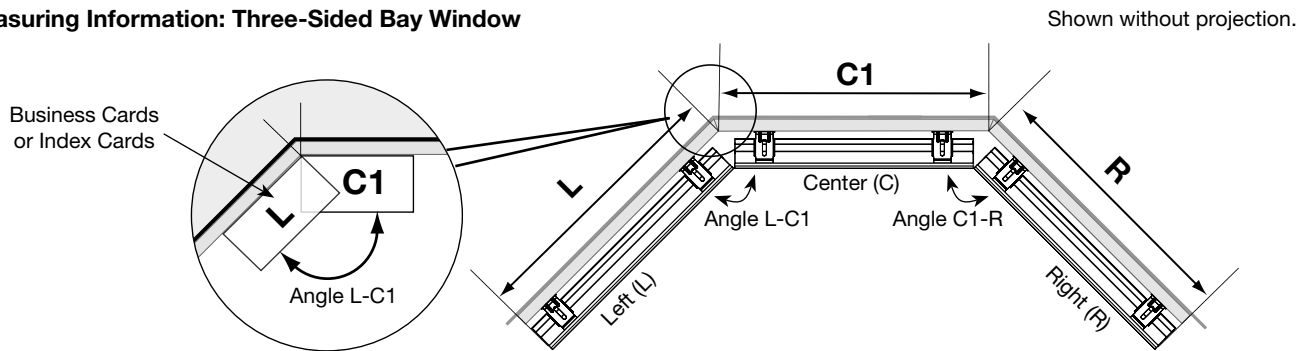
Options

Bay Windows



- **No charge**
- Made as individual shades
- Each section will have its own control
- Manufacturer will take appropriate deductions for proper fit; DO NOT order as a corner shade if you do not want manufacturer to take deductions
- **Cornices or decorative wood valances are not available on corner windows**
- Flat style is recommended for bay windows
- Looped style will have light gaps due to fabric loops

Measuring Information: Three-Sided Bay Window

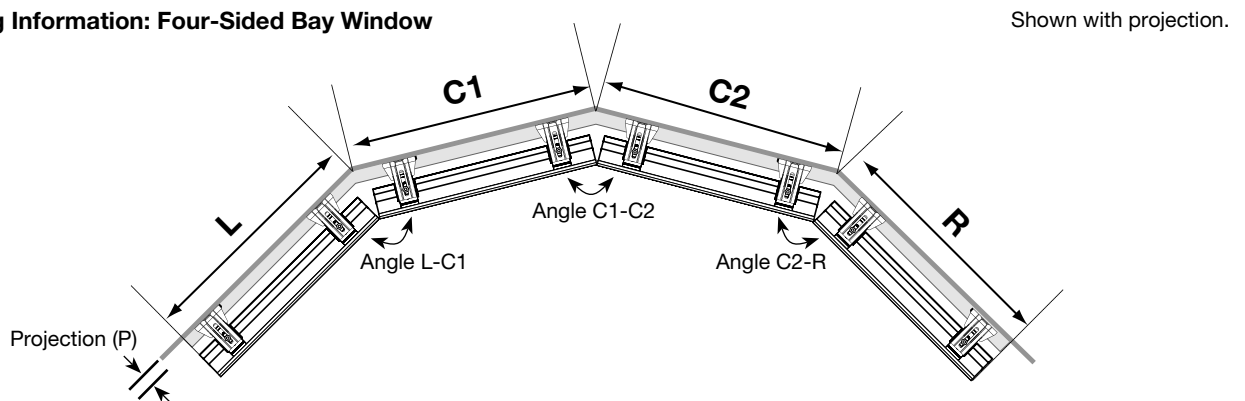


Measure:

- L and R:** Width of each side window from the corners on the mounting surface to the point you would like to cover.
- C1:** Width of the center window on the mounting surface from corner to corner.

- Angle L-C1:** Angle between the (L) and (C1) windows.
- Angle C1-R:** Angle between the (C1) and (R) windows.
- Projection:** If needed: The depth of the trim or molding the shade will be mounted above.

Measuring Information: Four-Sided Bay Window



Measure:

- L and R:** Width of each side window from the corners on the mounting surface to the point you would like to cover.
- C1, C2:** Width of each center window on the mounting surface from corner to corner.

- Angle L-C1:** Angle between the (L) and (C1) windows.
- Angle C1-C2:** Angle between the (C1) and (C2) windows.
- Angle C2-R:** Angle between the (C2) and (R) windows.
- Projection:** If needed: The depth of the trim or molding the shade will be mounted above.

NOTE: The projection (P) distance is needed to correctly calculate deductions for installations where the shades will use shims or projection brackets to clear trim or molding. All projection distances must match for correct deductions to be calculated.

For additional windows on bays with up to five sides, continue with number progression for center shade sizes (C1, C2, C3, ...) and angles (angle C1-C2, angle C2-C3, ...), as needed.

Measure each bay angle using a protractor or angle finder, or use two business cards in each bay corner as illustrated above and fax to customer service 1-800-552-4559.

The angle to use between adjacent center bay windows along a straight section of wall is 180 degrees.

Bottom Panel Heights

The standard panel height is 6" for flat and 4⁵/₁₆" for looped style. Bottom panel is used as the adjustment panel to get to finished shade height. The bottom panel height varies depending on shade height. A small change in finished shade height can create significantly different looks.

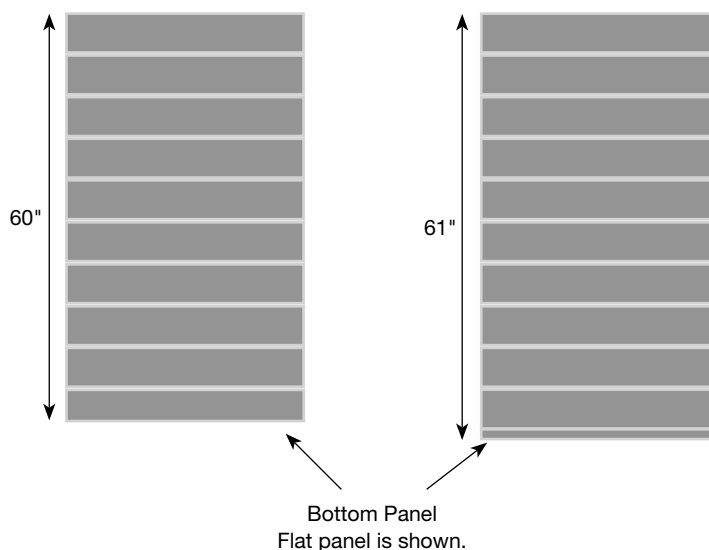

IMPORTANT ORDERING NOTE:

For shades hanging in the same room at the same height or for groups of shades, please add the words "hanging side-by-side" to the order comments. This is important for the manufacturing process and for panel adjustments.

It is very important to consider this possible variation when ordering more than one shade for a room. For approximate panel counts, see the following pages.



General Information

Panel Count Chart: Continuous-Loop Lift, Cordless and Motorized Lift

The purpose of this information is to help the consumer visualize what their shade will look like by approximating the number of full panels and the bottom panel length. Full panel lengths are 6" for flat and 4 $\frac{5}{16}$ " for looped; however, the bottom panel is used as the adjustment panel to get to finished shade height. **Therefore, the bottom panel length varies depending on shade height.** A small change in finished shade height can create significantly different looks.

This chart should be used to compare the effect of various lengths. The information can vary depending on the pleat length tolerance.

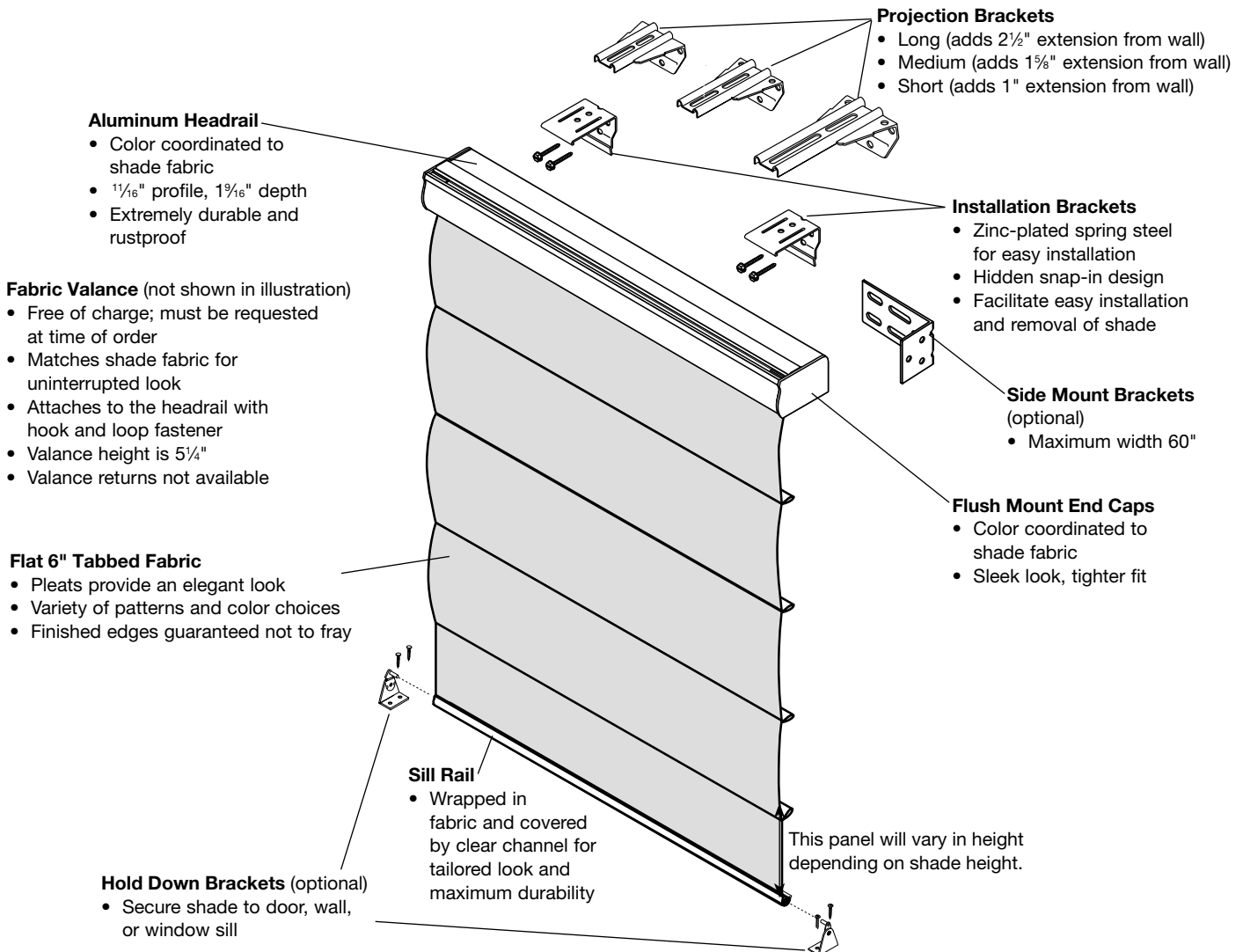

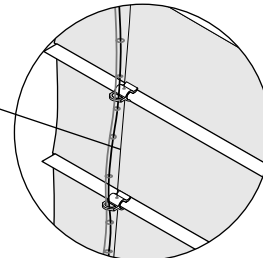
Flat Style Product Detail



Back View with Safety Loop Cord

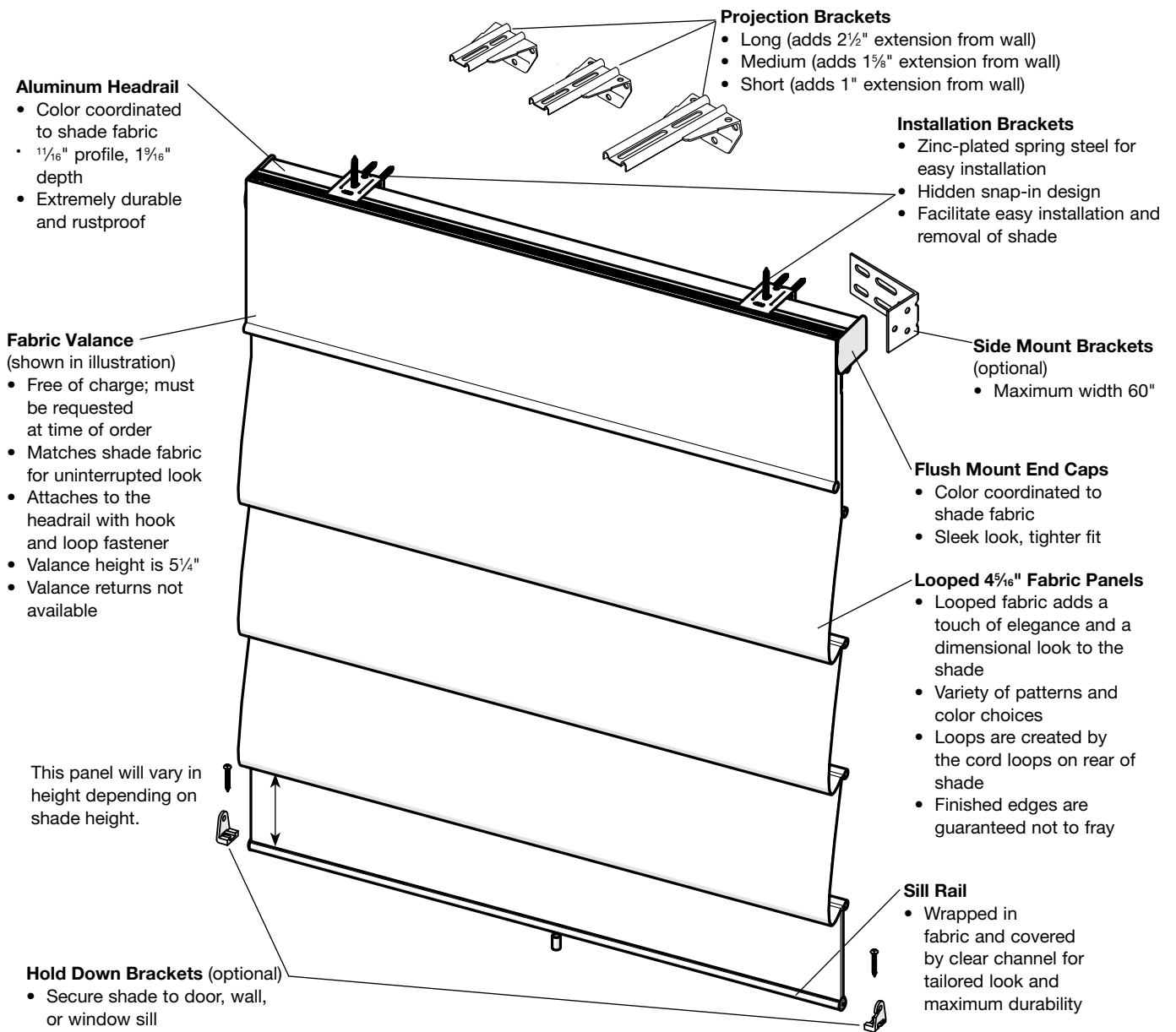

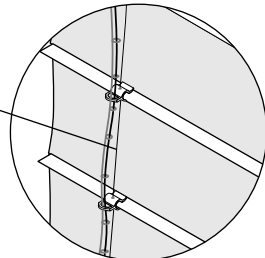
Looped Style Product Detail



Back View with Safety Loop Cord

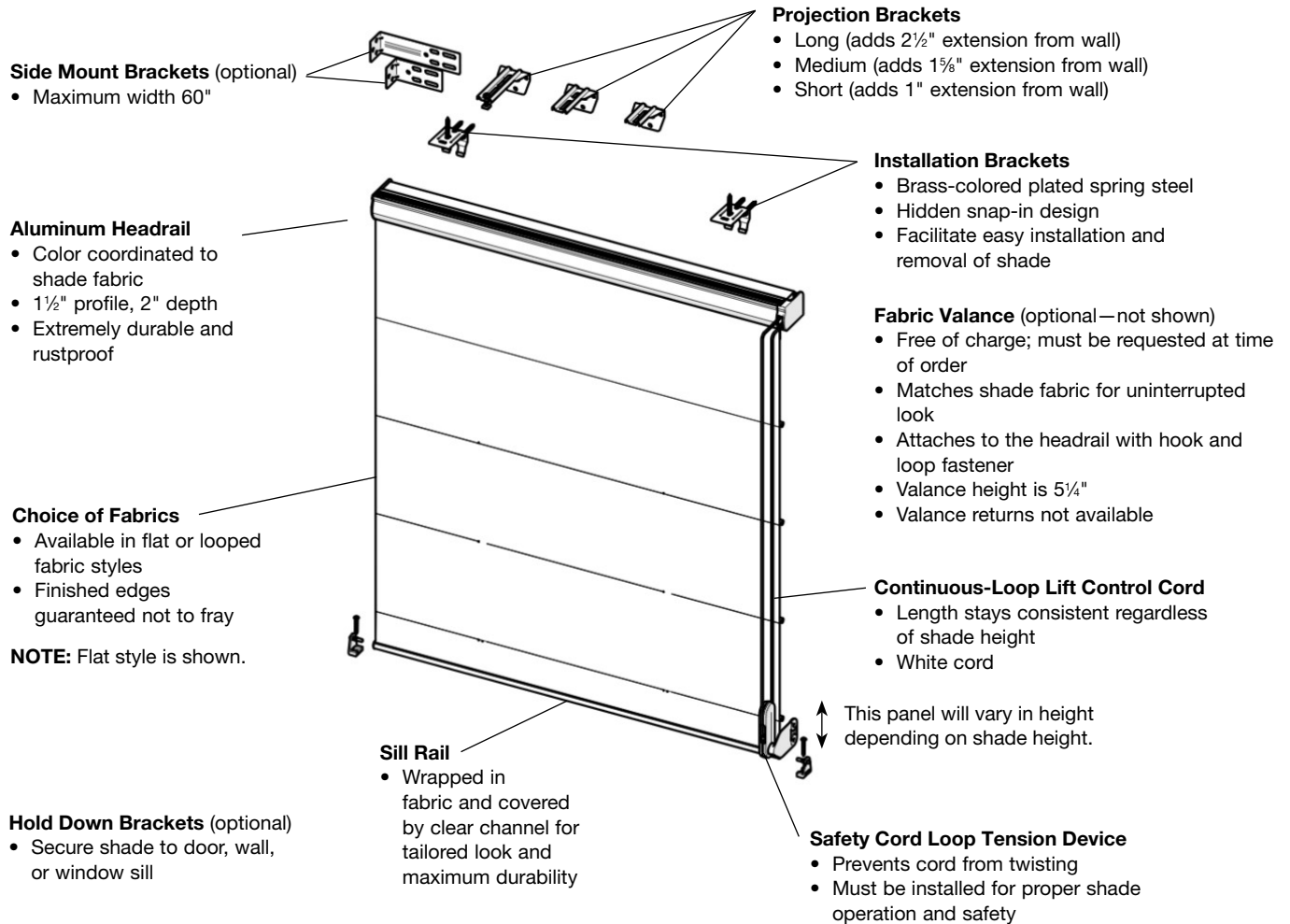

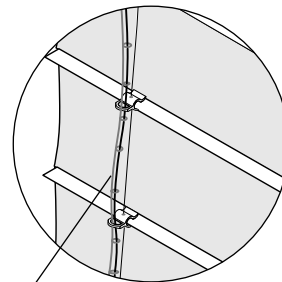

Back View with Safety Loop Cord

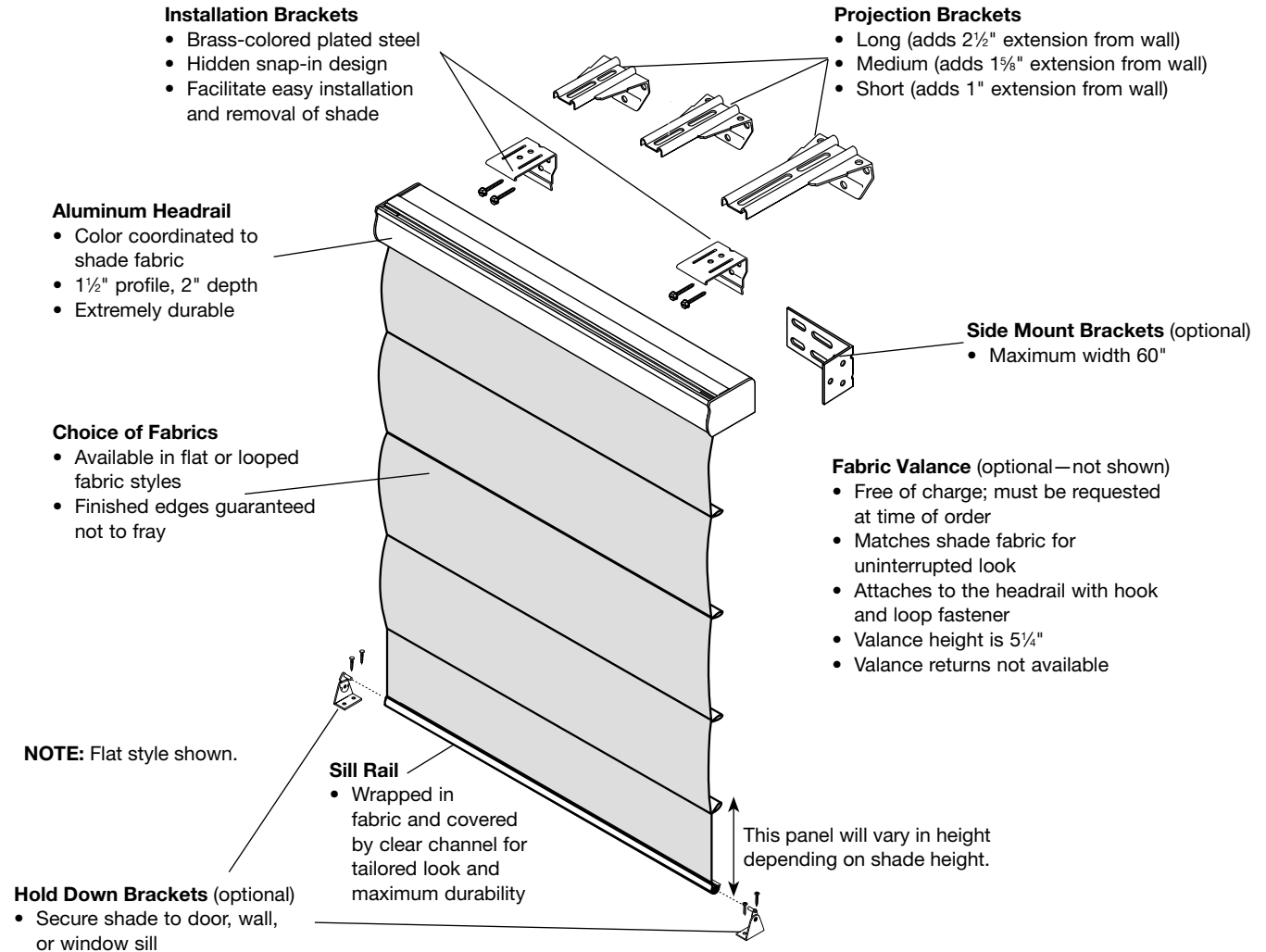

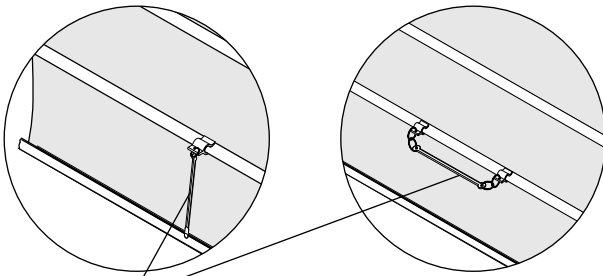

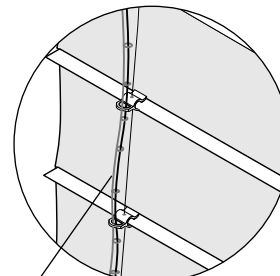
Back View with Vertical and Horizontal Wands
